Period: Over the period A.S.A.P. - 31 October 2007 (extension for one year may be possible)

Salary: About 8000 € in total is available for wages. Actual wages will depend on type of employment (*Angestellter, Hiwi*)*.

Base: The web-master will be based in the Institute for Geosciences, Tübingen University, Hölderlinstr. 16, Tübingen

Job description:

- Collecting content for the website from the organisers, lecturers, participants
- Creating web-forms for registration, etc.
- Responsible for security and updates of the website
- Attending the Summer School in Estremoz (Portugal), 20-30 August, 2007, to collect material for the website and instruct users
- Organising advertising for the Summer School
- Work is spread over the whole period, but concentrated in April, August and September, when the applicant *must* be available (i.e. no holidays then)

Job requirements:

- Knowledge of php-based websites and MySQL (The website is made with JOOMLA!)
- Fluency in written English
- Some knowledge of science, in particular materials science is helpful

(*) The total budget for this position is set by the EU at about 8000 €. This includes employer's social security levies, salary, etc.. The actual salary and number of hours per week will depend on type of position, education, marital status, etc. A rough indication is that a person with a PhD would work about 8 hours/week, for a total gross salary of about 6400 €/year. All necessary travel will be reimbursed by the project.
